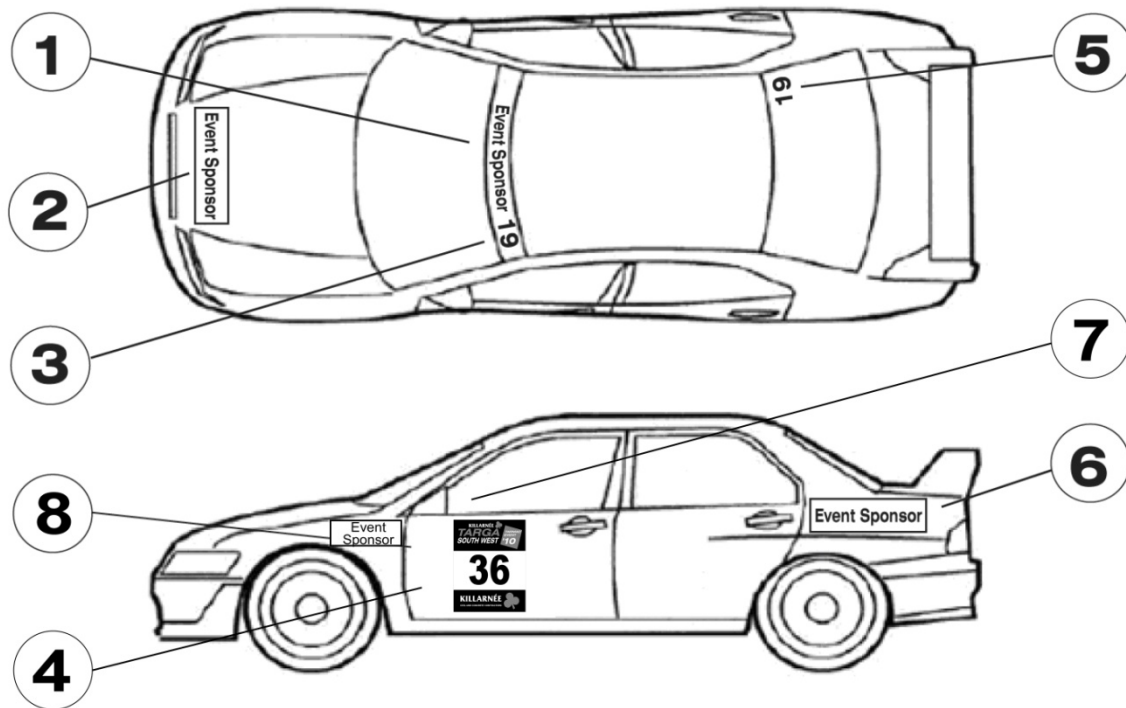


## APPENDIX I - VEHICLE SIGNAGE DIAGRAM



- Area 1: 10 cm H x 120 cm W Windscreen strip – Shannons Insurance
- Area 2: 15 cm H x 50 cm W - Shire of Manjimup
- Area 3: 10 cm H x 10 cm W - Competition Number on co-drivers side on front windscreen
- Area 4: 50 cm H x 40 cm W - Door Plate - Competition number & Killarnée Logo
- Area 5: 10 cm H x 10 cm W - Competition Number on drivers side on back window
- Area 6: 15 cm H x 50 cm W – Event Sponsor
- Area 7: 6 cm H x 15 cm W - Event Sponsor
- Area 8: 15 cm H x 50 cm W – Event Sponsor

**NOTE:** All Event supplied stickers MUST be affixed (without modification) to the vehicle according to these location instructions. Refer to section 4.7 for penalties. Should you have any difficulties in applying these stickers as outlined here on your vehicle, please consult the Chief Scrutineer or the Event Director prior to scrutiny.

## Vehicle Sticker Application Instructions

You have probably done this job many times before, but if you haven't here are some simple instructions on applying the various stickers to your vehicle....

1. Ensure the area(s) on the car where the stickers are to be applied have been cleaned, polished and waxed.
2. Use a spray bottle filled with water and a small squirt of washing up detergent to wet the area thoroughly.
3. Peel off the backing paper on the sticker and position it roughly on the wet area.
4. Slide the sticker around to line it up in the right position.
5. Use a smooth plastic card or scraper (a Credit Card can do the job) to smooth out the sticker and remove the water from underneath. Start from the top centre and work side to side as you go down the sticker. This job is achieved with a few sprays of the soapy water over the face of the sticker to ease the path of the scraper.
6. Carefully dry off the sticker and the surrounding area with a soft dry cloth. Make sure you work from the centre of the sticker to the outsides when drying it off.
7. Leave the stickers on the car for approx. 12-24 hours before driving the car to ensure they have adhered completely. This is particularly important if it is raining.

To remove them after the event....

1. Leave the car in the sun for a few hours or use a hair dryer to warm up the stickers.
2. Starting from one corner, carefully peel off the sticker.
3. Lightly polish or wax the area/panel again.

Using the above method, you will have nice smooth stickers in the right place and they should stay there for the duration without issues.
